### Entry Fees:

Conformation - Minor, Puppy, Junior, Intermediate & Open Classes: Initial entry \$40.00, subsequent \$30.00

Obedience (all classes) and Conformation (Baby Puppy Class only): Initial entry \$35.00, subsequent \$25.00

(Initial entry includes charge for Catalogue, and VCA levy.) Please use separate form for each class/exhibit.

\***Open class exhibits must include the following information on their entry forms** - Breed Survey status, Hip & Elbow status. Copies of a 5-generation pedigree and Breed Survey certificate must also be attached (and copy of GSDCA 'Hneg' certificate for imported males.) No entries accepted without payment of fees.

## SPECIAL CLASS REQUIREMENTS

**Sire's and Dam's Progeny Parades:** Entry is automatic. A minimum of five progeny aged six months or over, and entered in the Conformation classes will be automatically catalogued with the Sire's (or Dam's) name and exhibit number; the Sire/ Dam need not be present or entered in the Show. The classes are non-competitive but will receive a commentary. Only Sires and Dams classified under the GSDCA Breed Survey Scheme are eligible.

**Breeders Group:** Minimum five animals, from at least 2 Sires and 2 Dams, separate entry form must be received by the closing date - no entry fee. Details of animals competing must be handed to the Show Secretary by the commencement of judging on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> August.

**Obedience Teams Event:** Teams of four exhibits, exhibits can be mixed from different sections of obedience - Names of teams, handlers and dogs' names must be provided to the Trial Manager prior to the commencement of the Trial. At least three of the exhibits must qualify, exhibits entered in more than one class must nominate which class is to be scored.

**Veteran's Parade:** For animals who are now retired from competition and were graded "Excellent Select, or won "Winner of Winners" in Obedience at a previous Main Breed Exhibition. Please notify Secretary of intention to exhibit, by closing date (resume required).

## JUDGING TIMES:

### SATURDAY 13<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST:

**Conformation** - Vest Collection 7.00am, judging commences at 7.45am. with Baby Puppy Dog & Bitch Individuals, Minor Puppy Dog & Bitch Individuals followed by Junior Dog & Bitch and Intermediate Dog and Bitch Individuals. Lunch Break approximately 12.00pm. followed by the runoffs of each class starting with Baby Puppy Dog and Bitch. (\*Veterans Parade to be held during lunch break.)

**Obedience** - Vetting/check in from 7.00am to 7.45am. Judging commences 8.00am. Judging for "Winner of Winners" (Novice, Open & Utility class winners with qualifying scores) is to be held at the conclusion of Trial.

\* Obedience competitors also competing in the Conformation classes must advise their appropriate judge/steward, and must make themselves available either before, or as soon as possible after competing in the conformation ring.

\* All class winners to attend trophy presentations following completion of show classes on Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> August.

### SUNDAY 14<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST:

**Conformation** - Sires Progeny assembly at 7.30am. to commence at 7.45am. SHARP, followed by Breeders' Groups, followed by Puppy Dog and Bitch, Open Bitch and Open Dog. It is anticipated that Puppy Classes, and Open Dog and Bitch individuals will be completed by lunchtime, thereby leaving the afternoon for Open Bitch and Open Dog runoffs. (\*GSDCV Demonstration Teams Challenge to be held during the lunch break.)

Note: Open Dogs and Bitches will be required to GAIT OFF LEAD and will be GUN TESTED.

\*ONLY THOSE PEOPLE WITH AUTHORISED PASSES ARE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE JUDGING RINGS

## SCHEDULE OF CLASSES:

Conformation - Baby Puppy - three months to one day under six months, Minor Puppy - six mths to one day under nine mths, Puppy - nine mths to one day under twelve mths, Junior - 12 mths to one day under 18 mths, Intermediate - 18 mths to one day under 24 mths. Open 24 months and over. (Ages apply from the first day of the show.) **There will be no inter-sex or inter-class competition in the conformation classes.**

## SPECIAL PRIZES:

**Conformation** - Trophy and Sash for Sieger & Siegerin, Trophy & Sash for Vice Sieger & Siegerin, Trophy and Sash to all class winners and Breeders Group Winner. Sash and memento for second to tenth place. The Sam Bonifacio Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the most successful breeder over the two days; points are awarded for placegetters in each class. Rules may be viewed at the Show Secretary's Office.

**Obedience** - Trophy and Sash to all class winners (qualifying scores only) and Winner of Winners, sash and memento for second to fifth place. Trophy and Sash for "Best Dual Performance" exhibit in show & trial. Rules for the Dual Performance Trophy may be viewed at the Show Secretary's Office.

## GRADINGS:

**Conformation** - Gradings will be awarded at the Judge's discretion: 'Promising' and 'Very Promising' in Baby, Minor & Puppy Classes. 'Good' & 'Very Good' in Junior, Intermediate & Open Classes. 'Very Good Merit' in Intermediate Classes only, to exhibits that possess the A & Z Stamp. The grading of 'Excellent', and the medallion will only be awarded to exhibits 2 years of age or over, entered in the Open Classes and classified Cl.I or Cl.II under the GSDCA Breed Survey Scheme (or other GSDCA approved scheme.) Imported animals must possess a GSDCA A & Z stamp (or approved equivalent). In addition to the above, for an animal to be awarded the grading of 'Excellent Select' one parent must hold a GSDCA Breed Survey Cl.I or Cl.II classification (or approved equivalent), and imported males must possess a GSDCA Hneg. Certificate/clearance.

**Obedience** - Gradings will be awarded to those exhibits achieving the following scores, 'Good' 170 - 179 points, 'Very Good' 180 - 189 points, and 'Excellent' plus medallion for scores of 190 - 200 points.
