# of the WUSV meeting

# on September 6, 2010 in Nürnberg

### 1.) Administrative matters

The judge of the Working Bitch class, Herr Erich Bösl, introduced the bitches in his class to whom he awarded the rating "V-Auslese" and "V".

The judge of the Working Male class, Herr Reinhardt Meyer, introduced the males to whom he awarded the rating "V-Auslese" and "V".

### 2.) Report by the President of the WUSV and the General Secretary of the WUSV

At this juncture President Henke reported about the good cooperation with the FCI and with the German Kennel Club, the VDH.

He also informed those present about the SV Board of Directors election in December. The SV National Training Director, Herr Günther Diegel, has announced that he will not run for re-election, but all other Board members will be candidates.

President Henke then informed those present that Herr Hartmut Setecki, the Executive Director of the SV, had been appointed as WUSV General Secretary *protem* 

In addition, Herr Günther Diegel (Germany) and Herr Francis Reuther (France) have been appointed to the WUSV Central Commission by the Board of Directors of the WUSV.

President Henke referred to the successful, ongoing discussions with the Mexican WUSV club, representatives of the VDH and the FCI, as well as with the representative of the Mexican Kennel Club, Herr Dr. Payro

Central Commission member Herr Imran Husain was serving as intermediary in China between the WUSV club, the CSV, and a club that is under the Ministry of the Interior. President Henke announced that the contract with the second club will expire in October, and cannot be extended since attempts to find a consensual solution had lasted two years.

President Henke informed those present about the deployment of Herr Jinfei Chen in matters within the P. R. China. The WUSV Board had thus decided to honor Herr Chen with the WUSV Silver Pin. Herr Yukio Yamada was also honored with the WUSV Silver pin because of his service in Japan.

Herr Schallegruber, as Audit Committee member, reported briefly on the WUSV 2009 fiscal year.

### 3.3 Ratification of the activities of the WUSV Board

Herr Schallegruber moved that the actions of the WUSV Board be ratified. The actions of the Board of Directors of the WUSV during the past year were approved unanimously.

### 3.4 Election of the Audit Committee

Herr Schallegruber and Herr Rudin were nominated and each was elected by acclamation to serve on the Audit Committee of the WUSV.

Herr Francis Reuther was nominated as an alternate member of the Audit Committee. He accepted the nomination and was elected by acclamation

### 3.5 Election of the Accountants

The firm of Geißelmair, Mertl, & Partner of Augsburg was recommended to serve once again as Accountants for the WUSV and was approved by acclamation.

### 3.6 Status of dues/deposits/initiation fees

President Henke reported that several countries had not yet paid their WUSV dues for 2010. He provided the information that clubs that do not pay their membership dues will not receive judges.

In addition, it was announced that several clubs had registered Judges for the WUSV-Schutzhund Judges' seminar in Darmstadt who did not attend. Unfortunately, not all of them paid their resulting hotel bills. These countries will be asked again, urgently, to pay their bills.

### 3.7 2010 Budget

The 2010 budget was approved by acclamation.

### 4.) Election of the Members of the WUSV Board

### 4.1 Formation of the Election Commission

Herr Clemens Lux, Herr Hartmut Setecki, and Frau Martina Haussmann were chosen for the Election Commission. Herr Lux was elected Chairman by the Commission.

### 4.2 Election of:

# 4.2.1 President pro tem.

Herr Lux announced that Dr. Tauber was standing for re-election. Dr. Tauber stated that he would accept the position if elected. No other candidates were nominated.

Dr. Tauber was elected by acclamation.

The body elected Dr. Tauber, unanimously, to be President *pro tem* of the WUSV.

Herr Dr. Tauber thanked the body for the trust that they had placed in him.

# 4.2.2 1st additional Board Member

The previous holder of this position, Prof. Dr. Landau, declared that he did not wish to stand for re-election. He thanked the body for the trust that they had placed in him during the previous four years and nominated Herr Imran Husain as his replacement. No other candidates were nominated.

Herr Husain was elected by acclamation

# 4.2.3 2<sup>nd</sup> additional Board Member

Dr. Erkki Läike and Herr Roberto Caputi were nominated. Both men agreed to accept the position if elected. Herr Caputi introduced himself.

The election proceeded by written ballot.

The results were the following: of the 243 possible votes, 224 valid votes were cast. 155 votes were cast for Herr Dr. Erkki Läike 69 votes were cast for Herr Roberto Caputi

Herr Dr. Erkki Läike is thus elected as the 2<sup>nd</sup> additional Board member

Herr Dr. Läike thanked the body for their trust in him.

President Henke thanked Herr Caputi for his involvement.

The Chairman of the Election Commission, Herr Lux, declared the election to be completed and turned the gavel back to the Assembly Chairman, Herr Henke.

At this juncture President Henke thanked Prof. Dr. Landau for his commitment to the WUSV and for agreeing to continue to support the WUSV, above all with the organization of the WUSV World Championship in the U.S.A. in 2013.

**6.) Amendments to the WUSV Bylaws** (Bylaws text in normal print is the "official" translation on the web; text in **bold print** is translated from the minutes.)

# 6.1 Amendment to: Sec. 17 Passing Resolutions and Competence to Pass Resolutions of the Members' Meeting

Old version:

(2) The Meeting is competent to pass a resolution if at least 1/5th of the member associations is present.

### New version:

(2) The meeting is competent to pass a resolution if at least 1/5 of all **votes** of the member associations is present.

The Amendment was approved by acclamation (with two abstentions).

### 7.) Introduction of the Stephanitz-Medal

President Henke reported that the introduction of a Stephanitz-Medal is being planned.

# 8.) Reciprocal recognition of working titles, show ratings, certificates and/or other titles.

The representative of the Spanish Club, Real CEPPA, then reported about the difficulties with the registration of dogs in Spain. A hand-out was distributed:

### Suggested text for recognition of trial titles and entry possibilities

If there are two or more WUSV Member Clubs in one Member Country, each Member Club is obliged to allow the members of the other Member Clubs in the country to participate in its events unless the member is under suspension by the event giving club.

In as far as possible, WUSV Member Clubs should accept trial results, show ratings, certificates and/or breed surveys of other Member Clubs. If the trials results, show ratings, certificates, and/or breed surveys are given on the basis of an appropriate ordinance of the WUSV by a WUSV-Judge or WUSV-Breed Survey Master, all Member Clubs of the WUSV are obliged to recognize them completely.

The Assembly agreed by acclamation to proceed according to this document.

### 9.) Expulsion of WUSV Member Clubs

### 9.1 Club Ovejero Aleman Del Paraguay, Paraguay

The item is moot since the club has paid its outstanding obligtions.

### 9.2 Malaysian Kennel Association of Malaysia, Malaysia

The club is withdrawing from membership in the WUSV of its own accord and is simultaneously recommending its member club, the German Shepherd Dog Club of Malaysia. The membership is thus transferred to the German Shepherd Dog Club of Malaysia.

# **14.)** Report on the 1<sup>st</sup> International German Shepherd Congress in Valencia, Spain President Henke reported about the successful event and indicated that it should certainly be continued, perhaps in Mexico or Asia.

### 15.) Retrospective on the 22nd WUSV-World Championship 2009 in Krefeld, Germany

The event was reviewed. The criticisms that had been submitted had been evaluated, with the consequence that the WUSV Championship in Seville will begin a day earlier because of the large entry

Furthermore, the WUSV Board decided that the meeting on Monday following the WUSV Championship will only be open to Team Captains so that the problems with the event can be discussed effectively.

### 17) WUSV Championships

### 17.1 Qualification for countries with two member clubs

The WUSV General Secretary, Herr Lux, again explained that countries with two WUSV member clubs will have to hold a joint qualification trial. The purpose is to insure that the best dog-handler teams, regardless of club membership, represent their country at the WUSV Championship.

The body approved this procedure unanimously.

### 17.2 Entrance requirements

President Henke explained that a set of rules was being created to clarify the entrance requirements. Dr. Tauber explained further that for 2010 a SchH3 title obtained by each dog-handler team will be needed. As of 2011 the team must have a passing, qualification score with at least 250 pts. As of 2012 they must also have scored at least 80 pts. in each phase. As of 2015 appropriate qualifications for the Judges awarding the titles will be required.

### 17.3 Agility

The organizers of the WUSV Championship in Seville, Spain explained that there would be no Agility competition in 2010.
